

Generic Name: Promethazine

Trade Name: PHENERGAN

Class: Anti-emetic//Antihistamine

Indications: Nausea/Vomiting
Adjunct to analgesics/narcotics to potentiate their effect

Action: Antiemetic
Potentiates actions of analgesics.

Contraindications: Hypersensitivity to the drug
Patients who have used large amount of intoxicants (alcohol, narcotics, etc.)

Caution in Use: Extrapyramidal symptoms have been reported following use.
Benadryl should be available.
Increase incidence in extrapyramidal symptoms in patients taking MAOI.

Adverse Reactions: Drowsiness, dizziness, faintness, tachycardia and bradycardia

Doses: **Rate of administration should not exceed 25 mg/min**
Adult: 12.5 mg-25 mg IV or IM
Peds: 0.5 mg/kg IV or IM
Supplied 25 mg/ml ampule

Route: IV, IM
