GENERAL WEAKNESS/ILLNESS

FIRST RESPONDER

I. Management

- A. Establish and maintain the airway, provide oxygenation and support ventilation.
- B. Position patient on either side if vomiting; otherwise supine.
- C. Obtain vital signs (blood pressure, pulse and respiratory rate).
- D. Do not allow patient to take anything by mouth.

BASIC LIFE SUPPORT

- E. Arrange for ALS intercept.
- F. Initiate transport towards ALS intercept, if transporting unit.

NOTIFY RECEIVING FACILITY


ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT

- G. Monitor EKG
- H. Consider **IV NORMAL SALINE @ TKO** depending on the clinical circumstances and the results of the EKG monitor.


