

Ondansetron (ZOFRAN®)

Class: Antinauseant

Actions: Blocks actions of chemicals in the body that can trigger nausea and vomiting.

Rx: Nausea/Vomiting

Contra: Patients with known liver disease or Long QT syndrome, or that are hypersensitive to the drug. Do not give if patient is hypersensitive to dolasetron or granisetron.

SE: Blurred vision, temporary blindness, weakness, shivering, shaking, anxiety.

Dosage: 2 – 4 mg IV slow or IM.

Peds: 0.1 mg/kg slow IV, or IM. Max: 4 mg.

Notes: May precipitate with bicarb.

Supplied in SVMCA Drug Box: 4mg/2ml vial
